1 : the quality or state of being precise
: EXACTNESS

2 a : the degree of refinement with which an operation is performed or a measurement stated — compare ACCURACY **2b**

b : the accuracy (as in binary or decimal places) with which a number can be represented usu. expressed in terms of the number of computer words available for representation
<double *precision* arithmetic permits the representation of an expression by two computer words>

3 : RELEVANCE **2**
