







5.3 Multi-Element Symbols

Switching functions may be more clearly depicted and the diagram made easier to read by showing the contacts of switching devices separated from each other and from the actuating coil. Each set of contacts **shall** be clearly identified by the reference designation.

Female Contact, General		The general female contact symbol shows connections that represent the socket portion of a connector system.
Male Contact, General		The general male contact symbol shows connections that represent the pin portion of a connector system.
Ferrite Bead		A ferrite bead a passive electric component used to protect high frequency noise in electronic circuits.
Jack, Phono		A phono jack is a socket commonly used in the audio/video market to connect to sound amplification and image systems.
Jack, Phone, 2- Conductor		A 2-conductor phone jack is a socket that connects to voice and audio systems.
Jack, Phone, 2- Conductor Interrupting		A 2-conductor interrupting phone jack symbol represents a socket that connects to voice and audio systems and permits interruption of the existing audio.
Jack Phone 3-		A 3-conductor phone jack symbol represents a socket that connects
